X-Base Assembly Instructions

Tool(s) Required:

A. ¾" Wrench

B. 1x (3" Column)




C. 4x (Glides/Levelers)

F. 1x (Threaded Rod)



G. 4x (End Caps)




H. 1x (Split Washer)




Attaching Nut to Threaded Rod


A. Thread 2 of the Nuts (Part D) onto one end of the Threaded Rod (Part F). It does not matter which end of the rod you choose. Hand tighten the nuts together, turning one clockwise and one counterclockwise, leaving about 5/8" from the end of the rod to the bottom of the lower nut.




2 Attaching Threaded Rod & Post to Base


- **A.** Place the Base (**Part E**) on a hard surface. The side with the four holes for levelers should be on the ground. There should be just one hole visible in the center facing up.
- B. Insert the end of the threaded rod with the 2 nuts into the center hole of the base. Screw in until it is snug. Using a ¾" wrench, tighten the bottom nut first by screwing clockwise until it is tight as possible. Then do the same with the top nut.









A. Place the Top Plate (**Part A**) onto the column, the threaded rod should come through the center hole of the top plate.



B. Place the Split Washer (**Part H**) over the threaded rod, followed by a nut. Using the ³/₄" wrench, tighten down the nut as much as as possible until the top plate is securely fastened.



C. On each of the feet of the X-base, push in the End Caps (Part G) and screw in the Glide/Levelers (Part C).



Your X-Base is now fully assembled!
